And now, very soon, you'll get to read it! I couldn't be more excited. And nervous. And...hopeful. This book is full of hopefulness and risk-taking and madness and mystery and beauty and LOVE. Here's a short description:

Paris, 1886. Emily Dickinson has just received a fatal diagnosis. Instead of retiring to her room as the doctor has ordered, she sails to Paris, where, on the streets of Montmartre, she meets striving artist Vincent van Gogh. The two spark an electric connection that changes the course of their art, their lives, and the world forever. Told in poems, letters, and many of Emily and Vincent's actual words, this story imagines a world in which two of the greatest and most beloved creative minds experience a love greater than all the starry nights.
